Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Year 9 Tutor Sessions

As I am sure you are aware the government has requested that schools put plans in place for face to face contact with wider groups of students before the end of this school year where possible.

We are delighted to be able to welcome Year 9 back into school for a tutor session commencing Monday 6 July. The purpose of this session is to discuss their overall well-being since we last saw them, to provide information on new safety procedures they will encounter when they return to the academy and to prepare them well for further learning from home, including providing hard copies of a range of resources where relevant.

Whilst we believe having the students back is absolutely the right thing to do it is essential that we do so safely and with minimal risk.

To ensure the safety of all students and staff at the academy we have the following expectations:

- It is the responsibility of students and parents/carers to ensure social distancing is observed on the journey to and from school. Students should not use public transport.
- Parents and guardians are not allowed on site.
- Students must enter school at the allotted time at the allocated entrance only.
- Students are not allowed to congregate with each other
- No bags or equipment are to be brought onto the site.
- No food or drink is to be brought onto site.
- Students must not have any physical contact with each other.
- Everybody is to stay 2 metres apart at all time and respect social distancing.
- Students enter school at the allotted time at the allocated entrance only.

Any students who may have medication such as inhalers will be expected to bring them in a clear plastic bag.

Precautions the academy will be taking include:

- Ensuring that students are seated following physical distancing guidelines
- Ongoing cleaning of the building throughout the school day and a deep clean each Friday.
- Students not being allowed to walk around the building unaccompanied
- All students and staff following the Health and safety expectations without exception.



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- Requesting students and staff with Coronavirus symptoms at home. Please do not send your child to their
- Tutor session if they have a high temperature.
- We are relaxing our uniform policy to reduce the risk of transferring infection. Students should wear their black trousers/skirt and a white shirt. For the time being ties and blazers are not permitted.

So in summary, your child will be allocated a time for them to attend the academy for a meeting with their tutor group as described above.

Please email or call the Academy to indicate if your child will NOT be attending. No response will indicate that we will expect to see them for their appointments from the 6 July onwards when they have been asked to attend.
