



Effective revision strategies for RELIGIOUS STUDIES

1. Vary your revision with different activities to test your memory in as many ways as possible. For example:
 - a) answering practice questions
 - b) writing down notes from memory (brain dump)
 - c) making flashcards for small pieces of knowledge and then ensuring you test your memory using the cards. You could get someone to test you!

2. Study with a friend and test each other's knowledge. Putting each other under pressure before an exam is a great way to see if you are confident with your knowledge.

3. As you revise, make sure you are able to explain:
The importance of the belief / practice?
Why it is practiced?
What is its purpose?
