- Results will be distributed outside where the amphitheatre is situated.
- You will be given a timeslot for when you can collect your results (see below). This is to ensure social distancing measures are in place and respected.
- There will be a strict one way system in place; please enter through the gates at the main entrance and leave through the exit gates. Please do not gather in large numbers. There will be other safety measures in place too, for example, we will provide hand sanitiser as you enter.
- If you are unable to attend results day, please email askyear11@bca.warrington.ac.uk, providing a personal email address so your results can be emailed out.
- If you are feeling unwell, displaying symptoms of Covid-19 or are self-isolating, you should not attend Results Day under any circumstances. In this event, please supply us with a personal email address. You can do this by contacting askyear11@bca.warrington.ac.uk
- Parents will not be able to accompany you past the school gates.
- There will be staff on hand to support you with any questions you may have on the day.
